The first-century BC lex sacra from Ptolemais (S.B. I, 3451 = S.E.G. XLIII, 1131) is significant because of the ways in which it conforms to and departs from purity rules known from across the ancient Greek world. Discusses the fourteen-line long text with particular attention to the pollution stemming from miscarriage, delivery and nursing, and child exposure. - The lex sacra from Ptolemais. - An (im)migrant's cult? [Demeter?].
