

Marco Perale, P.Vindob. G 26768a: Non-Antimachean Thebaid (with Possible Associated Fragments from Other Collections).

Enrico Emanuele Prodi & Stefano Vecchiato (edd.), Φαίδιμος Ἑκτωρ. Studi in onore di Willy Cingano per il suo 70° compleanno = Antichistica. 31. Filologia e letteratura. 4 (Venezia, 2021) pp. 327-335.

Argues that the hexameter adespoton on P. Vindob. Graec. Inv. 26768a (= MP3 530; LDAB 1256) does not cover the events preceding the race between Atalanta and Hippomenes, and that it is not by Hesiod. Like P. Oxy. VI, 859 (= MP3 1776; LDAB 219) and P. Oxy. XXX, 2519 (= MP3 88.3; LDAB 220), it gravitates around the conversation between Atalanta and her son Parthenopaeus, and his subsequent departure to join the Seven. None of the three fragments would come from Antimachus' Thebaid, where Parthenopaeus is said to be the son of Lysimache.
