

Emanuela Borgia, Su un orecchino in bronzo di epoca proto-bizantina da Antinoupolis.

Analyses an elaborated bronze earring found at Antinoupolis in 2019, unfortunately in a superficial layer. The earring consists of a circular hoop with a bulla on the front and a glass bead on the other extremity; it was also provided of a hanging pendant. Through the examination of its characteristics and morphology we can date it in the early Byzantine age, more precisely in the 5th-7th century.

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
