Studies the phrase ὦϊόν διδύμον found in the mutilated order P. Cair. Zen. IV 59602, 2 from the Zenon archive. Thorough research both on the interpretations of the adjective διδύμος in connection with the ὦϊόν in various modern lexica of ancient Greek language and on excerpts from certain zoological treatises of Aristotle and Pliny's Naturalis Historia interprets the phrase ὦϊόν διδύμον as 'double-yolked egg'.

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
