Dimitris Roumpekas, Ὁιὸν δίδυμον (P. Cair. Zen. IV 59602, IIIa, Philadelphia): some remarks.

Studies the phrase Ὁιὸν δίδυμον found in the mutilated order P. Cair. Zen. IV 59602, 2 from the Zenon archive. Thorough research both on the interpretations of the adjective δίδυμος in connection with the Ὁιόν in various modern lexica of ancient Greek language and on excerpts from certain zoological treatises of Aristotle and Pliny's Naturalis Historia interprets the phrase Ὁιὸν δίδυμον as 'double-yolked egg'.
