P. Ant. I, 27 [= MP3 280; LDAB 723] is a single parchment leaf that contains §§ 49-56 of Demosthenes' De Corona. This specimen, published by C.H. Roberts in 1950, shows several features that justify a new analysis, first of all its accurate layout and its calligraphic majuscule. So, P. Ant. I, 27 represents a good example of an early codex, that proves to be a luxury product capable of containing great portions of text.

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
