Introduction: four funerary stelae of the eighth century AD, previously assigned to Abydos; they probably do come from the same cemetery, of uncertain location, but the provenance of Abydos cannot be proven. - 1. Stela commemorating Brother Makaris, the deacon. - 2. Stela commemorating Kyriakos, the monk. - 3. Stela commemorating Philippos, the monk (754 AD?). - 4. Stela commemorating Antonios, the monk (728 AD).
