The word $\pi\hat{\omega}\lambda\circ\zeta$ indicates a young animal. The expression $\pi\hat{\omega}\lambda\circ\zeta$ $\mathring{\alpha}\beta\circ\lambda\circ\zeta$ seems to indicate young donkeys. When a young camel was indicated, either $\pi\hat{\omega}\lambda\circ\zeta$ or $\mathring{\alpha}\beta\circ\lambda\circ\zeta$ was used. We surveyed all the instances of the word $\pi\hat{\omega}\lambda\circ\zeta$ as attested in the published documents so far in order to clear out the references to a certain animal.
