

Antonio Ricciardetto, Critical and Utilitarian Sigla in the Adespota Greek Hexameter Texts on Papyri.

Trends in Classics 15 (2023) pp. 359-379.

Lists all the critical and utilitarian signs attested in the 247 Greek surviving hexametric papyri of the Ptolemaic, Roman and Byzantine periods. These sigla are either directly associated with editorial work or were added by the scribe or corrector to provide the reader with practical information about the text. In doing so, aims to better understand how the ancients conceived the writing of poetic works, and how they read, cited, and used them.
