Most of Menander's papyri date to the Roman age, while only a few of them can be assigned to the Ptolemaic period, when the circulation of a large number of comic adespota is however attested. Intends to provide an overview of the Ptolemaic papyri found in the Arsinoite nome that have been assigned to Menander, including some dubious attributions and passages in anthologies, with the aim of providing a better reconstruction of the circulation of the poet's works during the first centuries after his death.
